Text: Titus 2:11,12 Grace teaches us how to live holy.

- Review:
1. There is grace to overcome any sin of the flesh. Even the sin of homosexuality and fornication (I Thessalonians 4:3,4). We partner with a ministry here that will help you get deliverance.
 2. Grace is the operational power of God released towards us to bring salvation or deliverance from whatever Jesus redeemed us from.
 - a. II Corinthians 8:5-7 There is a grace for everything.
 - b. God says, “*My grace is sufficient for us*”.
 - c. There is grace to be a good mother, father, children, employee, employer etc.
 - d. We are saved by grace through our faith.
 3. Colossians 2:8 We must be at war with philosophies of this world.
- I. What is your philosophy of repentance? How do you view it? Religion?
- A. Sin is missing the mark or coming short of the glory of God.
 1. Proverbs 24:16 The righteous fall but get up again.
 2. Our philosophy of repentance must come from the Word. It is our manual for life and living (II Peter 1:2,3).
 - a. If your philosophy is wrong? Eternity at risk? And life on the earth is affected (Galatians 5:21)
 - b. You need to read the Bible for yourself. 6th grade level.
 - c. Ephesians 3:4 Read to understand the mystery.
 - B. Traditions of men on how we should dress, tattoos, etc.
 1. Fast and pray to get healed? God teaches us through sickness?
 2. God takes us from glory to glory not mess to glory. We need to have the right philosophy of repentance in order to go on to glory. What is real repentance?
- II. True repentance brings transformation.
- A. Religion teaches us that repentance is behavior modification.
 1. Behavior modification is a fruit of repentance.
 2. Why do people behave a certain way? Fear of going to hell?
 - a. True repentance will bring you glory.
 - B. Mark 1:14,15 “***repent ye and believe the gospel***” They go together.
 1. Repent means to have a change of mind and conduct will change.

2. Romans 10:9,10 We believe from our hearts not our mouths.
3. Proverbs 23:7 What we have in our hearts tells us what we believe. I can tell what you believe by how you live.
 - a. Proverbs 4:23 Issues come from the heart. Think success in order to ever be successful.
- C. Romans 2:4 God's goodness leads to repentance. We must think differently about what leads us to repentance. Not tragedies etc.
- D. II Corinthians 4:4 Satan blinds the minds.
 1. You must change your thinking about your behavior.
 - a. I Corinthians 15:34 "***awake unto righteousness...***"
 - b. If you think smoking weed is okay you won't quit.
 2. Consider stewardship verses ownership. My body is not mine.
- E. Romans 12:1,2 Renew the mind or have a change of mind.
 1. It is part of our worship to renew and present our bodies.
 - a. "***You may prove***" or have evidence.
 2. Successful marriages takes the renewing and sacrifice of body. Not about me anymore.
 3. Where are you getting information to change your thinking?
 4. Changing your philosophy is at the root of repentance.
 5. Get saved and renew your mind. We know those who don't.
 - a. Read your Bible and go to a church where they do.

III. Colossians 1:27,28 Christ in you the hope of glory.

- A. You need to see what is in you. The anointing of the anointed One.
 1. "*I can do all things through Christ...*"
 2. "*all my needs are met according to His riches in glory*"
 3. "*I don't walk as a mere man anymore*"
- B. Find yourself in the Word like Jesus did (Isaiah 61).
 1. Christian or Christ-like-one
 2. I struggled being holy until I discovered the Holy One in me.
 3. "***the hope of glory***" or the earnest expectation
 4. v28 Present every man perfect in Christ Jesus.
 - a. Jude 24 "***present you faultless***"
- C. Real repentance is having changed my mind of who I am in Christ.
 1. Godly sorrow vs getting caught.
